



See below for NAKASEC affiliates' statement on SCOTUS overturning Roe v. Wade in the Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization case.

While this news was foreshadowed with the opinion leak in May, the pain and devastating consequences of it actually happening can not be overstated. Because of Texas' trigger law, in 30 days, abortion will be banned. This ban will deprive millions of Texans (especially those who are Black, Latine, Indigenous, Asian, Pacific Islander, Southwest Asian/North African, LGBTQIA+, low-income, without status, with a criminal conviction, with a disability) from accessing such an essential health service and lead to suffering and death.

Texans were already facing massive restrictions from SB8 and systemic challenges from health insurance (not expanding Medicaid), housing (lack of affordable units), transportation (lack of public transit), migration status (barring from public benefits and insurance), income/wealth disparities, etc. These mechanisms have led to many forced births and subsequent highest maternal mortality rates in the country.

For the community members we serve, we want to highlight and reiterate that Asians support and want abortions. From [NAPAWF's report](#) and resources: A [third of pregnancies](#) among Asian, Pacific Islanders end in an abortion. 93% of Asian, Pacific Islander women want to have the power to make decisions over their bodies and families. [74%](#) of Asians support legalizing abortion in all/most cases. **The liberation of our Asian and migrant communities is inextricably tied to the liberation of abortion.**

Woori Juntos is committed to fight for and aid Asian and all migrant Texans in any capacity during this time. We're also here to hold space for members who are grieving, angry, and needing community. At the end of the day: we protect us. Abortions have existed before Roe and will exist post Roe.
